

Are you interested in being a driver for Eagle River Day Camp?



If the answer is yes, then these are the steps to complete:

1. You must be at least 21 years old.
2. You must be available to drive all 8 weeks of camp, both in the morning and the afternoon.
3. You must obtain a CDL (Commercial Drivers License) before June 1. Save your receipts!
4. As compensation you will receive a \$3,000 tuition reduction for this summer.
5. You must provide camp with a \$300 refundable security deposit per our absentee policy.

To obtain your CDL (Commercial Driver's License):

1. Fill out a Staff Application from our website and mail it in. Please wait for a response from the office about the availability of a position.
2. Obtain the necessary paperwork from www.EagleRiverDayCamp.com/cdl.pdf. The package contains the following pages:
 - ✓ Instructions for Obtaining your Commercial Drivers License (CDL).
 - ✓ CDL Permission Slip.
 - ✓ NJ MVC Bus Application Unit Information Flyer and Declaration.
 - ✓ Sagem-Morpho, Inc. Fingerprinting Form (aka MorphoTrak).
 - ✓ Medical Examination Report.
 - ✓ 6-point Identification Verification.
 - ✓ CDL Manual (edited version).
3. Take the written tests and a simple driving test. You must take a general, 50-question multiple-choice test, a 20-question multiple choice test for the "P" Passenger Endorsement Test and a 20-question multiple choice test for the "S" Endorsement Test. Details are located in the online package.
4. Send a copy of your CDL and Medical Examiner Certificate to Eagle River.

If you already have your CDL:

1. Fill out a Staff Application from our website and mail it in. Please wait for a response from the office about the availability of a position.
2. Bring your CDL and Medical Examiner Card to Eagle River for the interview.

Pre-Camp

- Obtain your CDL License.
- Attend one orientation meeting and driver training at Eagle River in mid-June.
- Pick-up your van several days before camp begins.
- Find homes that are on your route and practice your run. Introduce yourself to the family.
- Send copies of fingerprinting receipt & Medical Examiner's Certificate (last page of Medical Examination Report) to camp.

A Regular Camp Day

- Drive your run in the AM and arrive at camp by 8:55 AM.
- Keep cell phone on while driving and during the day in case we need to contact you.
- Return to camp by 3:45 PM to check your afternoon paperwork.
- Drive your PM run.
- Park your van at your home overnight and on weekends.
- **Do not** use your van at any time except to drive campers.

After Camp

- Return your van to the camp parking lot on the last Friday of camp in the PM.
